God has always provided what I needed. It's more than just our spiritual vegetables or no sugar before dinner, God, as our heavenly father, truly gives us what we need when we need it. An encouraging word, an opportunity to redeem ourselves, and sometimes, just sometimes, exactly what we wanted too.
